Services and Rebates Offered

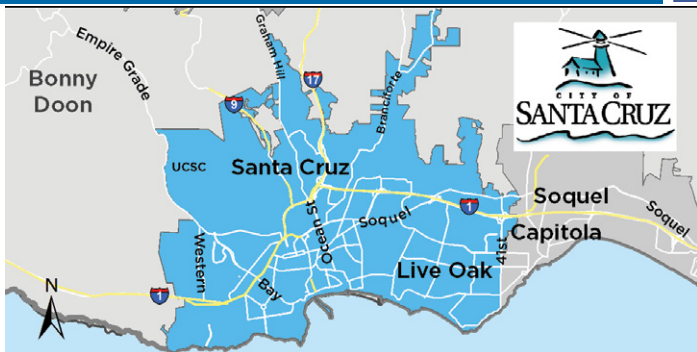
